#### **IMPORTANT ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION 13.10.2019**

To ensure the safety of runners and spectators, the Manchester Half Marathon has to be run on closed roads.

The closures will be in place for as short a time as possible and we shall help you get around as much as we can, but some people will be affected. To help plan your journey, please see the map overleaf showing which roads are closed and diversion routes.

Full details of the road closures, timings and traffic order can be downloaded via the event website.

Please come out to support the runners as they pass and enjoy the entertainment along the route. There is a prize of £500 for the Best Entertainment on the route with the winner decided by the runners themselves.

Manchester Half Marathon would like to thank you in advance for taking note of the information available and planning any journeys to cause you as little inconvenience as possible.



If you need to use the A56 Southbound, use the outer diversion route, A5103 Princess Road (Princess Parkway) to avoid major disruption to your journey.

If you need to access the City during the northbound closure, use Harboro Road or Glebelands Road to access the A6144 Carrington Spur to access the M60 or Carrington Lane for non-motorway traffic to access Flixton and Urmston.
